- Backpack Education Donation - Western Taylor County Public Library



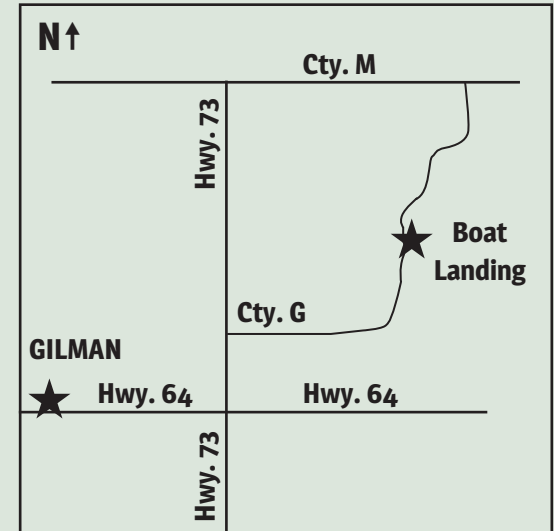

Where We Are Located



- North of Highway 29 (Thorp exit) on Highway 73 (16 miles) to County Road G, then east to boat landing and pavilion
- Using a GPS enter N4664 County Road G, Gilman, WI
- West of Highway 13 on County Road M (about 20 miles) to County Road G to Hooked At Outboards Bar & Grill, enter W13219 County Road M, Gilman, WI
- A ten-minute drive from Gilman
- Nearby towns and cities are Medford, Thorp, Cornell, Jump River, Sheldon, Holcombe, Perkinstown and Ladysmith, WI
